There are two components to this assignment:

1. Create a map. Your map could be a portrait of a real or fictional landscape, a visualization of an abstract concept, a network of connected ideas, a self-portrait, or anything else you can imagine. You may use Adobe Photoshop and/or Illustrator for this assignment.
2. Create a brief text to accompany your map. Your text should explain or expand on your ideas in creating the map, and should be about one page (between 300 and 500 words). Don't forget, you can be creative with the text component, too!

Assignment 6 is due by **midnight on December 10** (one week after our last class). As this is after classes end, there will not be an in-class critique of this work. The written element replaces this aspect of the assignment.

If you would like to submit your work in a different format (you might create a print or 3D object, or a video or some other type of file), please check with me before classes end about how to submit your finished work.
